STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The Delegation For Friendship Among Women is a non-profit, tax exempt corporation that was established to promote foreign exchange and cultural understanding among women leaders of the world.

Founded in Minnesota in 1970, the Delegation has distinguished itself by its diversity. Geographically, the members represent every region of the United States and professionally their backgrounds include academics, business, journalism, law, science and volunteerism. The organization is an autonomous and financially self-supportive group that receives briefings and assistance from the State Department.

The delegates have visited with key women leaders in India, Russia, The People's Republic of China, The Middle East (Egypt, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Kuwait, Lebanon, Syria and the United Arab Emirates) and have participated in the International Women's Year Conference in Mexico City in 1975 and the National Women's Conference in Houston in 1977.

The information and experience that the group obtains is then communicated to professional and civic organizations in the United States. This furthers the general objective of the organization which is to promote cultural appreciation and peaceful co-existence among the peoples of the world.
